## Writing for Publication – the first steps

**This Theory and Practical writing session is aimed at Adult and Child Care in an Acute and Community Setting at Novice writers**

### Biography:

Carole is a Chartered Physiotherapist/ Manual Handling Adviser. An Honorary and Advanced member of NBE she has written for a number of publications, including the Handling of People (BackCare, 2005, 2011), Guidance on Manual Handling in Physiotherapy (CSP, 2008, 2014) and Manual Handling of Children (NBE, 2011). She was Chairman of NBE (1999 – 2004), Public Relations Officer (2008 – 2014) and is currently managing editor of *column* and NBE publications officer.

### Abstract:

Writing for publication can be a daunting prospect. Often NBE members have a story to tell, ideas or a concept they wish to share, but stop in their tracks at the thought of putting pen to paper and submitting their work.

The session will give delegates ideas and tools to help, whether it is for producing a Continuing Professional Development portfolio, submitting an article for publication or simply for their own pleasure.
